blessed Trinity.

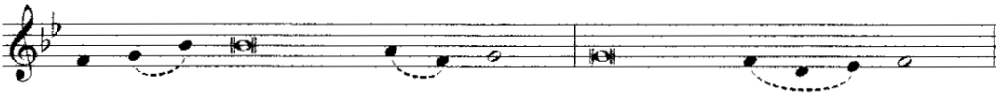
2. Holy, Holy, Holy!
